Intro/Outro

Twirl	2	S - S - S - TCH (turn 360 left), S - S - S - TCH (turn 360 right) L R L R R L R L
Step Touches	4	S - TCH, S - TCH, S - TCH, S - TCH L R R L L R R L
Twirl	2	S - S - S - TCH (turn 360 left), S - S - S - TCH (turn 360 right) L R L R R L R L

Part A

Doug Step	1	RS - BR UP - DS - RS LR L L RL
Turkey	1	H - T - S - DS - RS R R L R LR
Karate	1	DS - Kick - Turn ($\frac{1}{2}$ left) - DS - BR UP L R R L
Double Fancy	1	RS - RS - DS - DS LR LR L R

*** Repeat Same Footwork to Turn to the Front ***

Part B

Conga	2	S (xif) - TCH (ots) - S (xif) - TCH (ots) - Stomp - DS - DS - RS L R R L L R L RL
Push - off	1	DS - RS - RS - RS (<i>turn $\frac{1}{2}$ right</i>) R LR LR LR
Burton Basics	2	Dbl - Bounce - H - Up, Dbl - Bounce - H - Up L both R R R both L L

*** Repeat Same Footwork to Turn to the Front ***

Part C

Rocking Chair	1	DS - BR UP - DS - RS (<i>turn $\frac{1}{4}$ left</i>) L R R LR
Heel Walk	1	H - T - H - Turn (<i>turn $\frac{1}{2}$ right</i>) L L L R

Joey	1	DS - S (xib) - S (ots) - S (ots) - S (xib) - S (ots) - UP L R L R L R L
Basics	2	DS - RS - DS - RS (<i>turn 1/4 left, then 1/2 right</i>)

Part D

Vine Left	1	DS - DS (xif) - DS - DS (xib) - DS - DS (xib) - DS - RS L R L R L R L RL
Basics	4	DS - RS, DS - RS, DS - RS, DS - RS (<i>turn 360 right</i>)
Vine Right	1	DS - DS (xif) - DS - DS (xib) - DS - DS (xib) - DS - RS R L R L R L R LR
Basics	4	DS - RS, DS - RS, DS - RS, DS - RS (<i>turn 360 left</i>)

Break

Kick Charleston	1	DS - Kick - H - T - H - RS L R L R R LR
Triple	1	DS - DS - DS - RS (<i>turn 3/4 right</i>)
Step Touches	2	S - TCH - S - TCH R L L R
Stomp Double	1	Stomp - DS - DS - RS R L R LR

*** Repeat Footwork 4 Times to Make a Box ***

Intro - A - B - A - B - C - A - A - B - C - C - D - A - B - C - C - B - D - Break - Outro
